

President's Bi-Annual Report 2023–2025 Session

Bismillahir Rahmanir Rahim

Honorable Advisory Board Members and my beloved members,

Assalamu Alaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa Barakatuh.

First of all, we express our gratitude to Allah - Alhamdulillah and send Durood and Salam upon the beloved friend of humanity, the Holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW).

Alhamdulillah, we have successfully completed another two years of activities. We believe that more time is still needed to fully evaluate the true success of Belghar Rural Development Trust (BRDT). During these four years, whatever little we have been able to achieve has only been possible by the mercy of Allah and through your continuous support and cooperation.

The greatest achievement of BRDT has been creating a united platform for people of all ages and successfully implementing a large two-storied madrasa project that exceeded even our expectations. BRDT is a completely non-political and non-profit organization where everyone's objective is to stand beside helpless people in society and fulfil our responsibilities toward them solely for the pleasure of Allah.

Activities Conducted During the 2023–2025 Session

- We also designed an attractive logo for BRDT.
- In addition, over the last two years, we have carried out the following social welfare activities:

During the last two years (2023–2025), through donations from villagers and supporters, we collected a total of **4,345,643.00 Taka**:

- Madrasa Project: 3,480,338.00 Taka
- BRDT General Fund: 865,305.00 Taka

A total of **4,249,809.00 Taka** was spent:

- Madrasa Project: 3,490,541.00 Taka
- BRDT Social Welfare Sectors: 757,268.00 Taka

Currently:

- Bank Balance: 274,077.60 Taka
- Cash in Hand: 45,229.55 Taka
- Total Available Balance: 319,307.15 Taka

It should be noted that an additional 10,203.00 Taka from the BRDT fund was spent for the madrasa project. Therefore, as of **31 August 2025**, the organization's total balance stands at **329,510.15 Taka**.

Overview of Social Activities

1. Educational Support and Mentoring for Students

We consider student welfare extremely important because today's students are the future leaders of the nation.

Students were divided into three categories:

1. KG to Class Five
2. Class Six to Class Ten
3. Class Eleven to University Level

In Category A:

- 22 students received notebooks, pens, and school bags.

In Category B:

- 114 students received notebooks and pens.

A total of **63,765.00 Taka** was spent in these sectors.

Additionally, for Category C:

- 1,550 Taka was provided for purchasing books,
- 1,500 Taka for coaching fees,
- 4,500 Taka for examination form fill-up fees.

2. Support for Youth Physical Activities and Sports

To encourage healthy physical activities among local youth, sports equipment for badminton, football, and cricket was purchased.

A total of **6,230 Taka** was spent for this purpose.

3. Ramadan Iftar and Sehri Distribution for Needy Families

During the last two Ramadans, Sehri and Iftar food items were distributed among **152 families**.

A total of **213,413.00 Taka** was spent on these Ramadan activities.

4. Distribution of Semai and Sugar During Eid-ul-Fitr

During the last two Eid-ul-Fitr celebrations, **153 families** received semi, sugar, milk, and spices.

A total of **79,020.00 Taka** was spent on this initiative.

5. Qurbani and Meat Distribution During Eid-ul-Adha

During the last two Eid-ul-Adha celebrations, one cow was sacrificed each year and meat was distributed among poor families who could not afford Qurbani.

A total of **81,060.00 Taka** was spent, benefiting **85 families**.

6. Marriage Assistance for Poor Families

Alhamdulillah, we provided financial support for the marriages of daughters from six poor families.

The total assistance provided amounted to **81,000.00 Taka**.

7. Medical Assistance for the Poor

We were able to provide medical support to **9 patients**.

A total of **81,600 Taka** was spent in this sector.

8. Community Development Activities

As part of community development efforts, repairs were carried out for four houses.

A total of **51,400 Taka** was spent on these activities.

9. Flood Relief Activities

During the recent devastating floods, cash assistance amounting to **101,780.00 Taka** was distributed among **100 poor families** in affected areas.

In addition, BRDT members worked tirelessly to collect cooked food and relief materials from different places and personally delivered them house-to-house in the affected areas.

Free medical camps were also arranged at the mosque.

Those who participated in these humanitarian efforts deserve heartfelt appreciation and gratitude. May Allah accept your sacrifices and efforts.

10. Madrasa Building Project

The biggest dream and plan during this session was establishing a madrasa building beside the mosque. Alhamdulillah, through your cooperation, hard work, and support, we have nearly completed the madrasa project. After final finishing and decoration, the building will officially be handed over to the Madrasa Committee.

Reflections and Future Plans

One thing I noticed during this session was that because of the heavy focus on the madrasa project, we could not fully concentrate on broader social development activities.

Insha'Allah, once the madrasa project is fully completed, we will once again dedicate our full attention to community welfare and development.

We still have a long journey ahead. We must continue working tirelessly for the helpless people of our village. We want to bring smiles to the faces of suffering people.

In the future, if floods affect the village again, we may consider establishing a mobile charging power bank service for villagers during emergencies.

We also have plans to develop an official website for the organization.
